**Education Management Corporation (EDMC) is among the largest providers of private post-secondary education in North America, based on student enrollment and revenue, with 97 locations in 30 U.S. States and Canada.**

- EDMC was founded in 1962 and is headquartered in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.
- In 1970, the Company made its first acquisition, The Art Institute of Pittsburgh.
- John R. McKernan, Jr. is the Chairman of the Board of Directors; Todd S. Nelson is the Chief Executive Officer; and, Edward H. West is the President and Chief Financial Officer.
- EDMC has four primary education institutions that offer a broad range of academic programs concentrated in the creative and applied arts, behavioral sciences, education, health sciences and business fields, culminating in the award of associate's through doctoral degrees, as well as non-degree programs. In addition, Western State University College of Law offers the *juris doctorate* degree:

**Argosy University ([www.argosy.edu](http://www.argosy.edu))**, with 19 campus locations in 13 states, is dedicated to providing undergraduate and graduate degrees to students in a supportive learning environment where academic knowledge is enriched by the acquisition of interpersonal skills vital to success. Argosy University has five colleges: Psychology and Behavioral Sciences, Business, Education, Health Sciences, Undergraduate Studies.

**The Art Institutes ([www.artinstitutes.edu](http://www.artinstitutes.edu))** is a system of more than 45 education institutions located throughout North America, providing an important source of design, media arts, fashion and culinary arts professionals.

**Brown Mackie College** family of schools ([www.brownmackie.edu](http://www.brownmackie.edu)), with 24 school locations, is dedicated to providing educational programs that prepare students for entry-level positions in a competitive, rapidly-changing workplace. Brown Mackie College schools offers bachelor's degree, associate's degree, certificate, and diploma programs in health sciences, business, information technology, legal studies and design technologies.

**South University ([www.southuniversity.edu](http://www.southuniversity.edu))**, established in 1899, is a private academic institution dedicated to providing educational opportunities for the intellectual, social and professional development of a diverse student population. South University's seven campuses in five states offer educational programs at the associate's, bachelor's, master's and doctoral levels.

**Western State University College of Law ([www.wsulaw.edu](http://www.wsulaw.edu))** was founded in 1966 and is the oldest law school in Orange County with more than 10,000 alumni. Located in the heart of Southern California, Western State University has produced more California judicial officers than any other law school.

- Currently, online higher education degree programs are offered at The Art Institutes, Argosy University, and South University.
- EDMC employs approximately 20,212 full-time, part-time and adjunct faculty and staff.
- Collective enrollment of 136,000 students as of Fall 2009.
- Nearly 2/3 of EDMC students are female (63% women, 37% men) (as of Fall 2007)
- The average age of an EDMC student is 27.7 years. About 1/3 (34%) are between the ages of 20-24 years (as of Fall 2007)
- Each EDMC school is licensed by the state in which it is located and is authorized to confer its respective doctoral, master's, bachelor's, associate's and diploma/certificate level programs.
- All EDMC schools are separately or, collectively by education system, accredited by one or more independent accrediting agencies recognized by the Department of Education.
- Career Services offers a range of services and resources that support student career-planning efforts. Graduates from EDMC owned schools are employed by companies and organizations of all types and sizes, including some of the most prominent companies, such as: Sony Corporation, Adidas, Verizon, Ford Motor Company, Walt Disney Company, and more. Graduation rates and graduate employment statistics vary by school.
- EDMC is actively working with the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs in the "Yellow Ribbon" reduced tuition program, part of the post-9/11 G.I. Bill.
